Eighty-six parishes and missions received \$2,370,829 from the 2018 CSA to improve their aging buildings, update lighting, sound systems and HVACs; they repaired parking lots, reduced debts and made upgrades to parish halls; they supported Parish School of Religion programs, Catholic schools and various community outreach programs.



St. Vincent de Paul Parish, Wheeling

St. Vincent de Paul Parish in Wheeling was able to use the CSA funding to help reduce parish debt, to meet parish obligations to Central Catholic High School and St. Vincent de Paul Parish School, and they have plans to pave the main parking lot.



St. Matthew Parish, Ravenswood


St. Matthew Parish in Ravenswood used their CSA funding to help build a new parish hall that will give them space for events and allow them to spread fellowship and evangelization into the community.
